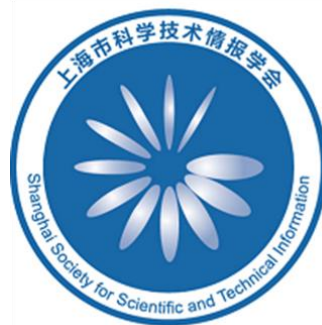


Welcoming Shanghai Society for Scientific and Technical Information



Founded in October 1979, **Shanghai Society for Scientific and Technical Information (SSSTI)** is a regional nonprofit membership community of science and technology intelligence professionals across industry, academia, and government who come together to build and share S&T intelligence analytics capabilities, patent analysis tools and methods. Our network of members stems from a myriad of organizations both profit and non-profit, with more than **70 group members and nearly 1,600 individual members** growing from the Yangtze River Delta to all over the country. In January 2012, the Society elected the 8th council and established **5 professional committees: academic, organizational science, enterprise intelligence, information technology, and intellectual property.**

As the largest and most active provincial-level industry-university-research intelligence consortium in China, **our mission is to enhance the success of our members through leadership, education, advocacy, and networking.** The Society organizes **nearly 40 activities per year** with more than 70 average participants. The Society has established **academic partnerships with the University of Western Ontario in Canada** on information measurement and network data mining. In addition, the Society regularly organizes members to participate in international conferences to exchange the latest developments in domestic and foreign competition intelligence, and receives expert visits from **scientific research institutions in Europe and the United States.**
